Database Customization

This section will only be included if applicable. It contains details about how the database will be customized according to the client's needs and specifications.

As a rule, this section will only include information not already covered in the Client Data Files section.

Supplementary Documents

This section will only be included if applicable. It a list of documents that provide additional information about database customization or additional instructions about how to handle data found in the client's files.

Client Data Files

This section makes up the majority of the mapping document. It list all of the data files sent by the client, along with detailed instructions about how the data in each will be migrated to Sumac.

For each file sent, we will include the following:

1. File Name
 - a) The name of the file sent by the client
2. Number of columns of data in the file
 - a) Only columns that contain column headers (titles) are counted
3. Number of records
 - a) The number of rows in the file that contain data
4. Number of contacts
 - a) This count includes the number of rows in a file containing information about contacts as well as any contacts listed in additional columns.
 - Example: where a file contains columns listing spouse names or childrens' names and birth dates
 - Example: where a file contains additional columns listing contact details specific for employees in an organization

5. Sumac records to be created

a) The types of records that will be created in Sumac from data in this file

- Example: Contacts, Donations, Communications

6. Special Instructions (if applicable)

a) This will only be included when there are additional instructions about how to handle this file.

- Example: Create additional contacts for children. Link them to the main contact with the relation type “child of”.
- Example: Give all contacts in this file the contact type “Volunteer”

7. Mapping Table

a) The mapping table contains details about what we will do with each column of data in the file. It contains four columns:

- Spreadsheet Column: Lists the title (column header) of each column of in the file
- Sumac Area: Identifies the area of Sumac (record type) the specified column will be migrated to
- Sumac Field Name: Identifies the *exact* name of the Sumac field that the specified column will be migrated to
- Details (if applicable): will contain additional details about how to migrate the data from the specified column

Multiple Files with Identical Columns

When several files contain an *identical* number of columns with *identical* column headers, and an *identical* set of instructions, we will treat them as a single file. The files will be listed together in the mapping, preceded by the following instruction:

- “The following files contain the same column pattern. Append them before formatting:”

Terminology

This section provides definitions and explanations for examples of instructions frequently found in data mappings.

Discard

When a file or column of data will not be moved to Sumac, we will enter “**discard**”, either below the file name, when the discard applies to the entire file, or under *Details* in the mapping table, when the discard applies to a specific column of data. We will also include the reason for the discard.

NB: This table lists examples of reasons for discard commonly found in data mappings.

In Data Mapping	Definition
discard: as per client's instructions	Indicates the client requested the discard.
discard: empty	Indicates that there is no data in the file or column, and therefore can be ignored during the actual data migration. This <i>does not</i> mean that this type of data cannot be recorded in Sumac. It just means that there is nothing to move into Sumac.
discard: no column headers	Files that do not have column headers will not be included in the data migration.
discard: not licensed	Indicates that the data in the file or column belongs in an add-on for which the client is not licensed. We will include a note that identifies which add-on the data belongs to.
discard: process data	Indicates that the data in the file or column is generated by the existing system or that it is used to generate other data. This type of data is common in database tables (age calculated from birth date, amount of all donations, date the record was last updated, etc.), but can also be found in spreadsheets (sums and other formulas).

In Data Mapping	Definition
discard: redundant data	<p>Indicates that the data in the file or column duplicates data recorded elsewhere in the data sent.</p> <p>This type of data is common in database tables that present the same information in various combinations (eg. FirstName; LastName; FirstName LastName; LastName, FirstName).</p> <p>Redundancy is also common when dealing with multiple spreadsheets. For example, a spreadsheet containing board member donations (amounts,dates, etc.) is likely duplicating data in a spreadsheet containing a complete history of donations.</p>
discard: unacceptable file format	<p>Files that are not in table format will not be included in the data migration</p> <p>Example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Word Documents, PDFs, PowerPoint Slides
discard values where records contain [blank]	<p>Indicates that a specific values are to be removed from records, as opposed to an entire column of data.</p> <p>discard values where records contain (000) 000-0000</p>

Instructions that Apply to Entire File

An instruction will appear in the specifications before a mapping table when the same value in a Sumac field will be applied to all the records in the file.

NB: This table lists examples of instructions commonly found in data mappings.

In Data Mapping	Definition
Give [records] the [sumac field] “[blank]”	<p>Indicates that all the records in the incoming data will be assigned the same value in the specified field.</p> <p>Example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Give contacts the volunteer type “Facilitator”

In Data Mapping	Definition
Where [columnname] contains data, use Business Address	<p>When individual & organization addresses are listed together in the incoming data, we put addresses belonging to individuals (people) in the Residence Address fields and addresses belonging to organizations in the Business Address fields.</p> <p>Example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Where Company Name column contains data, use Business Address.
Data in columns inconsistently entered	<p>Indicates that data in the file does not appear to correspond to column headers. This is a heads up that the client should take a closer look at the file before proceeding with the migration.</p> <p>Example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Phone Numbers column contains a disproportionate number of Postal Codes, Email column contains a disproportionate number of phone numbers, etc.

Details

If there are any special instructions for a column of incoming data, they will be entered in the *Details* column of the mapping table.

NB: This table lists examples of instructions commonly found in data mappings.

In Data Mapping	Definition
###	<p>Indicates we are unsure about something in the data.</p> <p>This does not mean we are questioning the validity of the data. It simply means we require some clarification in order to assign the data to the right place in Sumac.</p>
### client to advise	<p>Indicates that the client needs to get back to us about how to map a particular column of data. This will not appear in an initial data mapping, but after a mapping discussion.</p>

In Data Mapping	Definition
[add/subtract] to [datefield1] to obtain [datefield2]	<p>Indicates that a date is to be calculated based on a duration in the column.</p> <p>Example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Add to Membership Start Date to Obtain Membership End Date
against Sumac's recommendation	Indicates Sumac recommends a different instruction.
Append to data in [blank] column	<p>Indicates that contents of this column will be merged with the contents of another specified column.</p> <p>Example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Append to data in Donation Notes column.
Append with “[blank]”	Indicates the contents of the column will be followed with the text between the quotation marks.
as per client's instructions	Indicates that the data is mapped according to the client's instructions.
Assign new Sumac IDs	When two incoming systems use the same IDs to identify different contacts, new Sumac IDs will be assigned to the second set of incoming contacts.
Create [blank] contacts	<p>When a file contains columns with information about additional contacts, we will create new contacts in the database. Additional contacts will be given a lower case identifier in the mapping (spouse Contact).</p> <p>These additional contacts will be counted in the Total Number of Contacts listed at the beginning of the data mapping document.</p> <p>Example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Where a file has columns labelled <i>FirstName</i>, <i>LastName</i>, and <i>SpouseFirstName</i>, <i>Spouse Phone</i>, we will create a “spouse Contact”

In Data Mapping	Definition
Create [blank] communications	<p>When a file contains details for multiple communications per record, they will be clearly labelled.</p> <p>Example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Incoming data contains columns labelled <i>Date Application Received</i>, and <i>Date Acceptance Letter Sent</i>. • We will create two communication to records: “application Communication”, and “acceptance Communication”. • Columns containing details for each communication will be preceded by the appropriate lower case identifier (application Communication).
Identifies in which fields to put data from [columnname] column	<p>Indicates that data in another column is to be split up amongst several fields in Sumac. This is most frequently seen with address and phone number information.</p> <p>Example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A column labelled “PhoneType” identifies in which fields to put data from the “Phone”. (Residence Phone, Business Fax, Residence Email, etc.)
Link to [main contact] with relation type [blank]	<p>Indicates that additional contacts in the record will be linked to the main contacts using a specified relationship.</p> <p>Example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • records contains columns for names and birth dates of children of the main contact: “Link child1 Contact to main Contact with the relation type 'child of”.
Precede with “[blank]”	<p>Indicates the contents of the column will be preceded with the text between the quotation marks.</p>
Re-name [blank] to [blank]	<p>Indicates that an existing value should be re-named in Sumac. This instruction is usually added at the request of the client.</p> <p>Example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rename Counsellor to Leader

In Data Mapping	Definition
Re-name [sumacfield] field to	<p>A few Sumac fields can be re-named to suit the needs of the client. This indicates which field will be used and what its new name will be.</p> <p>Example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Re-name Renewal field to Date of Death
Split column on “[blank]”	<p>Indicates that data in the column belongs in separate fields in Sumac, and must be split into two or more columns. The character that should split the column will be identified between quotation marks.</p> <p>Example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • for a column containing [LastName, FirstName]: Split column on “,” <p>Variation:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • for a column containing [LastName FirstName]: Split column on last “[space]”. <p>NB – These are blanket operations performed indiscriminately on <i>all</i> values in a column. For this reason, a fair amount of post migration clean-up by the client may be necessary.</p>
Tab: [blank]; Name: [blank]	Used to specify the tab name and field name of an Extra contact field.
The values in this column belong in several different fields in Sumac. They will be assigned to the appropriate fields in Sumac, as outlined in the [FileName: ColumnName] document.	<p>Frequently, data currently being collected in a single field or column really belongs in a number of different fields in Sumac. When this is the case, we will create a separate document listing all the values listed in the column and identifying where each will go in Sumac.</p> <p>Example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a Donation Category column contains the values Golf Tournament, Board Donation, and Spring Mailing • These will be split amongst three fields in Sumac (Event: Golf Tournament, Donation Type: Board Donation, Campaigning: Spring Mailing).

In Data Mapping	Definition
Use [codes/IDs] in conjunction with [othercolumn values] to turn [blank] codes in other files into names.	<p>Indicates that data in this file is to be used to turn codes or IDs in other data files into full text values as mapped in this file. This is typically seen in databases when tables containing records (contacts, donations, etc.) are linked to tables containing lookup list values.</p> <p>Example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use DonationCategoryIDs in conjunction with data in Donation Categories column to turn DonationCategoryIDs in other files into donation category names.
Use data in [filename] to turn these codes into names	<p>Indicates that the corresponding name values for codes in this column are found in a specified file. This is typically seen in databases when tables containing records (contacts, donations, etc.) are linked to tables containing lookup list values.</p> <p>Example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use DonationCategories.xlsx to turn these codes into donation category names.
Use these IDs to link data in this file to data in [blank]	<p>Indicates that database tables in the incoming data are linked using the IDs in the specified column.</p> <p>Example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use these IDs to link donations in this file to pledges in Pledges.xlsx <p>Variation:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use these receipt numbers to add data in this file to donations in Donations.xlsx

In Data Mapping	Definition
where records contain “[blank]”	<p>Indicates that records containing certain values will be treated in a specified manner.</p> <p>Example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Donation/Cancelled Receipt, where records contain “TRUE” (Only records marked TRUE will be checked as having a cancelled receipt) • Where records contain “Paid”, create payment records. • Contact Type where records contain Board, Student, Stakeholder; Communication Preference where records contain Newsletter, Phone, Media

Duplicate Records

Because we cannot make assumptions about client data, we are unable to identify and completely remove duplicate records from incoming data. We will, however, employ some measures, at the time of migration, to reduce the number of duplicate contacts.

Contact Records

Where a single file contains contact information *in addition to* First and Last names, we will identify duplicates where the contact information in ALL contact fields is identical.

In order for records to be considered identical, ALL entries in ALL columns for each record must EXACTLY match those in another records.

This method of reducing duplicate contact records can only be performed within a single file of data. If the same contacts appear in several separate files of incoming data, they will have to be cleaned by the client after going live with Sumac.

Other Records

Since it is possible for multiple records containing identical details to exist in a database, we will not remove duplicate records of any type other than contacts.

It is the client's responsibility to ensure that the data they send for migration does not contain duplication.

Defaults and Standard Practices

There are a number of default values that we will apply to data during the data mapping and the data migration phase. Sometimes these are the result of missing information in the incoming data (to fill mandatory fields in Sumac, for example), or to allow Sumac's automatic functions (for example, using the correct address, selecting the most appropriate volunteer).

Unless otherwise stated in the data mapping, the we will employ the defaults and standard practices listed here.

Contact IDs

When two incoming systems use the same IDs to identify different contacts, new Sumac IDs will be assigned to the second set of incoming contacts.

The original contact ID will be retained in an Extra contact field titled “Original ID”.

A map of new IDs and their corresponding original IDs will be kept to ensure any other records using these IDs will be linked to the correct contacts during migration.

Gender

The gender “Organization” will be assigned to all contact records identified as organizations.

Addresses

Use Business Address

Unless otherwise specified, The *Use Business Address* checkbox will be checked where incoming data contains a business address.

Dates

Date Format

All dates in Sumac must be complete, and entered in the format yyyy-mm-dd. Where dates in the incoming data are incomplete, we will first look at column headers and file names to fill in the blanks. Otherwise, we will default to the following values:

yyyy: 1900

mm: 01

dd: 01

Example: if the date appears as 04/2015 in the incoming data, we will convert it to 2015-04-01.

Inconsistent Date Formats in Incoming Data

When inconsistent date formats appear in a single column, it is impossible to determine which values are month, day, or year.

For example:

2015-04-06 (either 04 or 06 could be day or month)

03/10/12 (any of these could be day, month, or year)

01-Apr-10 (either 01 or 10 could be day or year)

When dates are formatted consistently, we can usually identify day and year by looking for values that are higher than 12. But when several date formats are used in a single column of data, we cannot guarantee that dates will be accurate in Sumac.

Phone Numbers

Phone Number Formats

Sumac can be configured to follow *one* of the following phone number standards:

- North America (999-999-9999)
- Australia (99 9999 9999)
- United Kingdom (various)
- Mexico (various)
- Ireland (various)

Defaults for All Phone Numbers

If there are any errors with phone number formats, we will precede the number with “+”.

Phone numbers will be migrated to the field specified in the data mapping regardless of any text identifying otherwise in the data.

All non-numerical characters (text) will be deleted.

Example: The following appears in a column mapped to the Residence Phone field

- “123-456-7890 (fax)”
- It will be migrated to the Residence phone field as “123-456-7890”

We will create an error report containing all phone numbers with non-numerical

characters for your review after the data migration.

Default for North American Numbers

If the three digit area code of North American numbers is not in the incoming data, Sumac will default to “000”.

Email Addresses

Email Format

Email addresses in Sumac must follow this exact format, with each part (each different colour) formatted correctly:

- **username**@**domain**.**dnslabel**
 - Example: support@sumac.com
- the **username** cannot contain spaces or the following characters: "(),,;<>@[\\]
- The **domain** name must be made up of alpha numeric characters. Hyphens are allowed, provided they are not the first or last character.
- The **@** symbol and the dot-separated **DNS label** must be included.

Default Repairs for Email Addresses

Sumac will not accept email addresses that do not follow the exact format detailed above. We are able to fix the following common errors:

- Spaces in address: we will remove spaces
- Comma separating DNS label (,com): We will replace the comma with a dot (.com)
- Missing DNS label (support@sumac): We will default to “.com”

Other Errors in Email Addresses

Since errors other than those listed above would require guesswork on our part (eg. unacceptable characters, missing username, missing domain name), they will not be imported into Sumac.

We will create an error report containing all email address errors for you review after the data migration.

Appended Data

When the contents of two or more columns will be merged into a single field (column)

of data, the contents of each column will be separated by a semicolon followed by a space (“; ”).

Mandatory Fields

Each area of Sumac has at least one mandatory field. If the information necessary to fill these mandatory fields is incomplete or missing from the incoming data, we need to fill in the blanks.

The tables below lists all mandatory fields in each area of Sumac, and the default values we will use for each when missing from the incoming data.

Field Details (Maximum Lengths & Data Type)

Maximum Field Length

Every field in Sumac has a set maximum number of characters*.

If any incoming data exceeds the maximum for its field, we will cut off the text at the maximum and place the original (full) text in the Notes field of the corresponding record.

If the text is too long for the Notes field, we will provide you with an error report that contains the record details, including the full, unimported text.

Note: See Appendix A – Field Definitions for the complete list of fields with maximum character count.

*Characters are any letters, numerical digits, symbols (including punctuation marks), and whitespace (spaces between words).

Appendix A – Field Definitions

This appendix provides definitions for the fields in Sumac into which data can be imported.

Appearance in Sumac - Definitions

Checkbox

A single checkbox that, shows that a particular option chosen

Contact

A link to a contact record

Count

A whole number (integer), without decimals

Currency Amount/Decimal Number

A number with two decimal digits

Database Link

A link in a record to a Sumac record elsewhere in the database

Date

A full date, in yyyy-mm-dd format

Drop-down

Allows the user to choose *one* value from a list

Duration

A length of time, shown in hours and minutes

Multiple Checkboxes

Allows the user to choose *several* values from a list

Radio Buttons

A set of options, only one of which can be selected at any time

Text

Allows the user to input text, including alpha numeric and special characters

Time of Day

A definite time, as shown on a clock
